A walk-in interview is hereby called for eligible candidates for the contractual position of **Chief Technical Officer** (one position) in Guwahati Metropolitan Drinking Water & Sewerage Board (GMDW&SB).

Eligibility Criteria:

I. **Age:** Applicant should not be more than 62 years as on 01/01/2026.

II. **Educational Qualification:**

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or any other relevant engineering discipline from a recognized University/Institution.
- Preference may be given to candidates having Master's Degree in Civil Engineering/Public Health Engineering/Environmental Engineering/Water Resources Engineering/Water Supply & Sewerage Engineering or any other relevant engineering discipline.

III. **Working Experience:**

Minimum **15 years of professional experience** in the field of Water Supply, Sewerage, Urban Infrastructure or other relevant infrastructure projects, including experience in planning, design, project implementation, commissioning and operation & maintenance.

Preference may be given to candidates having:

- Experience in handling **large-scale Water Supply and Sewerage projects;**
- Experience in senior-level technical/engineering management and supervision of multidisciplinary technical teams; and
- Experience in **Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory/Autonomous Bodies, externally aided projects or reputed infrastructure organizations.**

IV. **Working Skills:** The candidate shall possess strong **technical leadership, project management and decision-making skills**, with sound knowledge of Water Supply and Sewerage systems, relevant engineering standards, codes, quality-control practices and applicable Government procedures. The candidate should also have the ability to effectively manage multidisciplinary technical teams and coordinate with consultants, contractors, Government Departments and other stakeholders.

V. **Eligibility of Retired Government Officers:** Retired officers from Central/State Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory/Autonomous Bodies and other Government organizations possessing the prescribed educational qualification and relevant experience may also apply.

Remuneration and Payment terms:

- Depending on the candidate's qualifications, experience, and competency, the consolidated fixed remuneration will be determined and mutually agreed upon. Tentative range is estimated between Rs. 1.50 lakh to 2.00 lakh. Applicable taxes shall be dealt with as per the prevailing law.
- In case a retired Government officer is engaged on contractual basis, the remuneration shall be fixed on the basis of the last pay drawn, as would be admissible at present, minus the pension being drawn by the officer, in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Personnel (A) Department, Government of Assam, from time to time.

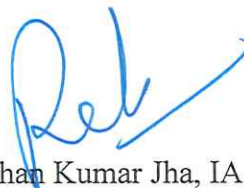
Documents to be Produced
